**Attention ALL Customers!**

According to West Virginia State law it is illegal for a customer to obtain access to a water meter pit or tamper with the meter in any manner. The pit and associated equipment belong to the Public Service District. In the event of illegal tampering with a meter, law enforcement authorities will be notified.

In the event the meter is turned on/off by the customer there will be a \$25.00 charge to turn the meter back off/on. In addition, if this problem continues to occur, the meter will be locked or removed until the situation is rectified.

Tampering with the meter pit violates West Virginia Codes 61-3-44 and 61-3-45. Customers sometimes damage the meter and/or valve which results in significant cost to the PSD.

If you wish to turn your water on and off, please install a valve after the meter on the property. All cost associated with damaged meters and equipment that are not the fault of PSD employees will be billed to the customer.
